ORGANIZATION

DO

- ✓ Have Set Rules and Expectations
- ✓ Plan Ahead

DON'T

- Be the exception to the rules
- Wait until the last minute

COSTUMES/UNIFORMS

DO

- Respect school property and Company Image Have a dress rehearsal
- ✓ Consider various body types

DON'T

- Eat, drink, or curse, etc. in or out of uniform
- Wear attire inappropriately
- Forget all members have different shapes and needs for their bodies

DANCE ROUTINES

DO

- ✓ Select Music First
- ✓ Consider ability and style of the team
- ✓ Include formation changes
- ✓ Include change of pace and level variety
- ✓ Correct errors as you see them
- Develop your own team style

DON'T

- Make the routine too difficult
- Select inappropriate music for a routine
- Stay in one formation the entire routine
- Include moves that are not lady-like
- Practice over mistakes
- Be intimated by other's talents

PERFORMANCE

DO

✓ Wear appropriate make up

✓ Encourage parents and friends to attend performances

DON'T

- Not follow the performance guidelines with makeup and attire
- Exclude your best supporters & Stay up late before a performance
- Do anything to bring embarrassment to the company

COMMUNICATION

DO

- Keep the team and Director informed
- ✓ Check the Team APP
- Have regular meetings with the officers and Director

DON'T

- Schedule surprise events/practices
- Cancel rehearsals or meetings

ATTITUDE

- DO
 - ✓ Be Positive
 - Show each other respect
- ✓ Listen to the each other DON'T
 - ✤ Be Negative or Disrespectful

PRACTICE/CLASS

DO

- Warm Up and stretch before each rehearsal or performance
- ✓ Start and Finish On Time
- Plan your rehearsal/get organized
 Wear appropriate practice clothes
- wear appropriate practice clothes on the designated days
- Practice sportsmanship

DON'T

- Get injured because you didn't warm up
- Delay rehearsal for a few late members
- Wait until practice to decide what to do
- Waste valuable time or wait until the Director tells you what to do
- Wear the wrong practice attire
