Below are the performance and grading requirements for each semester in dance. All performances are required for every student.

Fall Semester Performances – Winter Showcase, Fall Technique Evaluation, and Final Exam

Winter Showcase	3 Major Test Grades - 50 % of the student's 3 rd 6 weeks grades. Students who do not participate/attend will automatically receive three failing test grades.	Learn choreography in class, practice onstage, arrive on time for performance, wear appropriate costume, perform, be dismissed at the end of the concert.	The following reasons will not be accepted as an excuse to miss the performance: Work, Transportation, Out of Town, Family Commitments, etc. Please see your teacher if you have any questions.
Fall Technique Evaluation	2 Major Test Grades – 25% of the student's final exam grade. Students who do not participate/attend will automatically receive two failing test grades.	Learn choreography, practice movement/technique, and perform in class.	Students will have 1 mock test before they will be evaluated. Any student who is absent the day of the evaluation must make it up before their written final exam.
Written Final Exam	Final Exam – 25% of the student's final grade. Students are required to take their exam during the scheduled time. Exams will not be given early for any reason.	Complete and answer 100 – 150 question written exam.	Students will be evaluated over all material covered in the fall semester, this does include all written assignments and journal entries.

Spring Semester Performances – Any additional Dance Performance, Spring Show Performance, and Choreography Project

The following reasons will not be accepted as an excuse to miss the performance: Work, Transportation, Out of Town, Family Commitments, etc. Please see your teacher if you have any questions.
Spring Show Performance – All students must be passing on their 4 th 6 Weeks Report Card to be eligible to perform.	3 Major Test Grades – 50% of the student's final exam grade. Students who do not participate/attend will automatically receive three failing test grades.	Learn choreography in class, practice onstage, arrive on time for performance, wear appropriate costume, perform, be dismissed at the end of the concert.	All students must be passing on the 4 th 6 weeks report card in order to be eligible to perform. Choreography Project	Choreography Project/Final Exam – 25% of the student's final grade. Students are required to take their exam during the scheduled time. Exams will not be given early for any reason.	Create and perform a 2 minute routine with specific skills and choreography elements associated in the routine.	Students will be evaluated on their overall performance, as well as their individual technique.
